How does MTEP work?

With your approved application, you will be placed in a talent pool and matched with positions in other local government agencies in Santa Clara and San Mateo counties.

Program participants will be placed in another agency for three months to acquire new experiences, relationships and competencies. Your agency pays only \$1000 per participant.

In addition, your home agency may be eligible to receive a star performer from another agency who will bring fresh ideas, an eagerness to learn, and complementary skills.

- assistant to the city manager
- management analyst or similar position
- program staff
